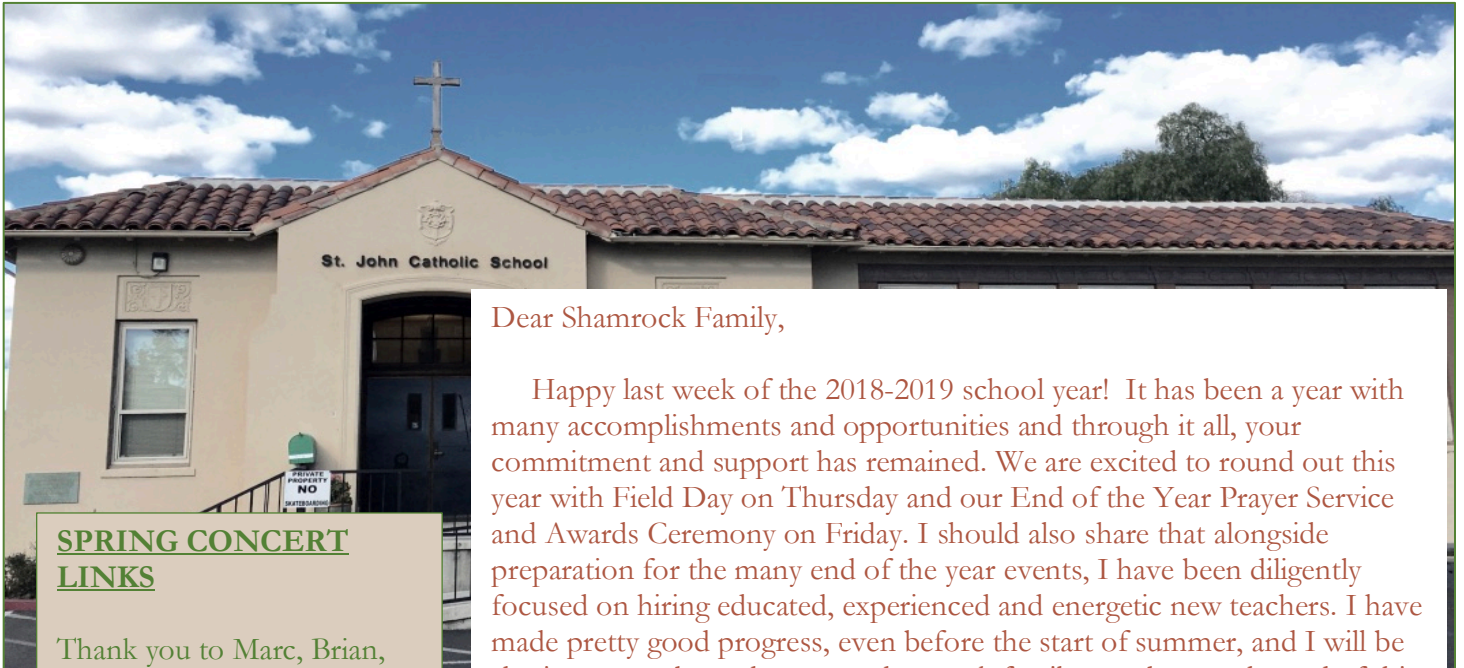

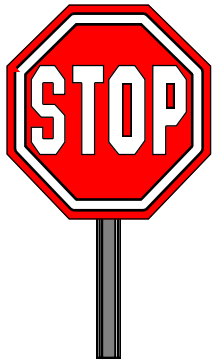

The theme of this year's **Summer Reading Game** is "A Universe of Stories". The Game will begin on June 1.
