I would like to share excitement around my visits to online classes over the course of the past three weeks, as well as gratefulness for and pride in the many positive emails I have received from parents regarding our start to the school year. It is apparent that our teachers, students, and families are choosing to embrace the virtue of fortitude as we continue to navigate distance learning. Here's to you, to us, and to our united spirit of fortitude and positivity!

Next week, I will be sharing in greater detail about our school successes so far this school year, as well as our planned aims for the weeks and months ahead, in my "Back to School Night" Principal's Address. As for "Back to School Night," scheduled for Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, this will be different in nature from our usual beginning of the school year parent event. Since we are not yet back on site and since teachers provided Parent/Student Orientations in August, we set aside time for another round of live, Q & A sessions with teachers, as a follow-up option for parents now that we are in the thick of the distance learning plans that were shared in August.

- **6:35-6:55pm** Level 2 Sessions (grades 3<sup>rd</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup>)
- **6:55-7:10pm** 6<sup>th</sup> grade (core middle school teachers on to answer parent questions)
- **7:10-7:25pm** 7<sup>th</sup> grade (core middle school teachers on to answer parent questions)

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- **7:25-7:40pm** 8<sup>th</sup> grade (core middle school teachers on to answer parent questions)

**Other Things to Note about the Q & A Event:**

- These live, Q & A sessions are optional for parents.
- Parents do not have to remain on any one call for the entire session time. Parents are welcomed to join and leave scheduled calls as is relevant to them.
- Parents, please know that these live Q & A sessions are intended to answer general parent questions pertaining to distance learning and/or class protocol or procedure. This is not a time intended for discussing individual student progress or concerns.
- Parents are encouraged to email teachers directly should they have student-specific questions or concerns.
- These Q & A sessions are for parents/guardians only, not for students.
- Teachers will send a follow-up correspondence to all parents summarizing the general questions that came up during each class Q & A session.

**What to Expect from the School in Preparation for the Q & A Event:**

- **By or before 9/8-** Teacher communication to parents about any new information, procedures or protocol relevant for parent review prior to the 9/10 Q & A Event.
- **By or before 9/8-** Teacher communication to parents about the optional, live, Q & A session and schedule, per grade.
- **By or before 9/9-** Teacher emailed Google Meet invitation to parents for optional, live Q & A session.
- **By or before 9/17-** Teacher follow-up correspondence to all parents summarizing the questions that came up during live, Q & A event.

Parents, we look forward to sharing with you and hearing from you as we embark on our next few weeks of distance learning. Our aim is still to plan for on campus return, when permitted and when is safe and appropriate for our school. May you know and feel God's love and blessings.

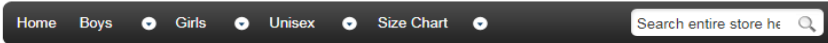
