Wednesday, February 16th Shamrock Pride Group Meeting I am happy to report that open house was a success, with most appointments filled for tours with prospective families. This week, we began welcoming families for new student testing and prospective family interviews. We are hoping for many new families to join our shamrock family this upcoming school year so that we can offset the cost to educate a child, as fixed costs, such as diocesan fees and employee salary and benefits are rapidly increasing.

As I shared in November, the pandemic has taken a severe toll on our enrollment. While it remains my every effort to continue to provide robust learning support and varied enrichment activities to our students,

enrollment directly affects our budget and our ability to offer services. With an enrollment decline of 72 students within the past two school years, I am focused on retention and marketing strategies to significantly increase enrollment for the upcoming school year. I will need the continued support of current parents and school families with efforts to grow our school community. Thanks to many of you who have shared about our school with others and to those of you who have already referred families. Below are our established tuition rates for the 2022-2023 school year. PROTOCOL FOR SYMPTOMATIC STUDENTS:

If a student is experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19, you will need to keep your student home and notify the school office. There are 3 options to clear your student to return to school:

1.) Provide a doctor's note stating the symptoms are not related to COVID-19

2.) Provide a negative result from a PCR COVID-19 test

3.) <u>FDA approved antigen test</u> if the test comes back negative, a second test will need to be administered 24 to 48 hours later. Antigen tests may not detect infection in the early stages, so a confirmation test is required. To use an antigen test to return to school you must provide the following to the office: a picture of the test card results with the name of your student and the date both tests were administered.

COVID-19 UPDATE:

We currently have three active Covid-19 cases to report- two within one family, and one other, unrelated case. At this time, there is no reason to believe that there has been any transmission at school.

STUDENT VACCINATION CARDS:

Parents, in order for us to properly follow Covid-19 isolation and quarantine protocols, we will need to be aware of which students are fully vaccinated or not. If and when your child is fully vaccinated, please send a copy of your child's vaccination card to Ms. Aimee- <u>asire@csdo.org</u>. You are welcome to stop by the office to have a copy made and placed on file for you as well.

The BASIC Fund is available for new students whose families meet all the application requirements. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022. Please also note, new siblings for current BASIC Fund students must request a link to apply for a new student. Like last year, BASIC renewals will be processed online.

FACE (Family Aid-Catholic Education) applications are available online only at <u>https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FVYB</u> or see the link on their website. This application requires documentation for income received in 2020. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022. I
