Dear Shamrock Family,

While county and diocesan guidance is allowing people to choose whether to wear a mask, I am asking that St. John Catholic School students, staff, and visitors continue to wear masks at school until May. My reasoning behind this request is two-fold. To begin, continued masking at school mitigates transmission of Covid-19 and many other illnesses, which will likely become more prevalent once our immune systems go back to hard work after almost 2 years of mask protection. With schools still mandated to uphold contact tracing, reporting, and quarantine and isolation guidelines, less cases not only keeps Ms. Aimee's and my workload around Covid-19 down, but it keeps students and staff at school for in-person learning! Secondly, as has been the previous trend when masking guidance loosens, more Covid-19 cases evolve. Ideally, we, as a school, could make

it to the week past returning from Easter break to make our masking optional so that any illness transmission may be mitigated after the holiday week. May 2<sup>nd</sup> is our Administration Team's preferred optional masking date. Should protocol around Covid-19 tracing/ reporting and quarantine/isolation change, amendments to this request may be made in advance of

the May 2<sup>nd</sup> date. We would greatly appreciate each individual's consideration and cooperation in response to this current request.

Applications are now available for FACE (Family Aid – Catholic Education) and The BASIC Fund financial aid.

The BASIC Fund is available for new students whose families meet all the application requirements. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022. For more information, please go to <a href="www.basicfund.org">www.basicfund.org</a> or see the link on our website. Current families please expect your renewal information early to mid-February, due back in April. Please also note, new siblings for current BASIC Fund students must request a link to apply for a new student. Like last year, BASIC renewals will be processed online.

FACE (Family Aid-Catholic Education) applications are available online only at <a href="https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FVYB">https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FVYB</a> or see the link on their website. This application requires documentation for income received in 2020. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION PLEASE READ: All families wishing to be considered for SJCS tuition assistance through the school must first apply for FACE and complete this Google Form <a href="https://tinyurl.com/2vzhubj4">https://tinyurl.com/2vzhubj4</a> before March 30, 2022. If you are currently receiving aid or wish to apply for the 2022-23 school year, you must first complete a FACTS application, apply for FACE, and complete the Google Form before consideration for SJCS tuition assistance. If you have any questions regarding FACE, BASIC, or SJCS tuition assistance, please contact us. Deadlines established by FACE and BASIC are firm; a missed deadline will mean a missed opportunity.


