The BASIC Fund is available for new students whose families meet all the application requirements. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022. Please also note, new siblings for current BASIC Fund students must request a link to apply for a new student. Like last year, BASIC renewals will be processed online.

FACE (Family Aid-Catholic Education) applications are available online only at https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FVYB or see the link on their website. This application requires documentation for income received in 2020. The deadline to apply is March 30, 2022. I


