Counselor's Corner

"Support School Efforts to Promote Good Discipline"

Your child's school works to teach children discipline, but educators can't do the job alone. Parents can help promote good discipline, too. Here's what you can do:

- **Change misbehavior** by setting positive goals. Concentrate on what you *do* want your child to do, not what you want him to avoid.
- Say what you mean and mean what you say. Clearly communicate expectations and limits. If you make a rule, enforce it every time.
- **Involve your child** in solving problems. Family meetings are a good way to develop cooperation with rules. Kids who have helped solve a problem are usually committed to the solution.
- **Keep corrections simple.** For example, use the broken record approach. When correcting your child, move closer to him. Just say his name. Then repeat the same phrase ("Homework now") over and over again.
- Impose logical consequences for misbehavior if you can.
- **Give choices**—but make sure you can live with them. Limited choices usually work best, especially for younger children.
- **Show your love.** Firm and kind discipline is an act of love—not a substitute for it. Children need to know you love them no matter what.

"Fomentar la Disciplina"

La escuela de su niño trabaja para enseñar disciplina a los niños, pero los educadores no pueden hacer el trabajo solos. Los padres pueden ayudar a formentar la buena disciplina, también. He aquí lo que usted puede hacer:

- Cambie el comportamiento estableciendo nuevas metas. Concéntrese en lo que usted quiere que su niño haga, no lo que usted quiere que evite.
- **Diga lo que quiere decir** y diga en serio lo que dice. Comunique las expectativas y limitaciones con claridad. Si establece una regla, haga que se cumpla cada vez.
- Involucre a su niño en la solución de los problemas. Las reunions familiares son una buena manera de fomenter la cooperación con reglas. Los niños que han ayudado a resolver un probema generalmente están comprometidos en la solucion.
 - Mantenga simples las correcciones. Por ejemplo, use el enfoque del disco roto. Cuando corrija a su niño, acérquesele. Sólo diga su nombre. Después repita la misma frase ("La tarea ahora") una y otra vez.
- Imponga consecuencias lógicas por mal comportamiento si puede.
- **Brinde opciones**—pero cerciórese que puede aceptarlas. Las opciones limitadas generalmente funcionan major, especialmente para los niños pequeños.
- **Demuestre su amor.** La disciplina firme y afectuosa es un acto de amor—no un sustituto de él. Los niños necesitan saber que usted los ama pase lo que pase.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have a couple new and exciting changes with regards to tuition and service hours for the 2018-2019 school year. The current three-tiered tuition structure will now be a two-tiered system and your service hour obligation will be adjusted based on under which tier your family falls. Additional information for these changes can be found on the tuition rates and fees sheet on the back of this sheet.

Attached to this letter is your registration form. This form is extremely important as we need to know exactly how many seats we have available to offer to new families looking to attend St. John Catholic School for the 2018 – 2019 school year. Your registration form is due back by April 25, 2018 accompanied by your registration fee of \$400 per student. (Incoming grades 5-7 please refer to Chromebook letter sent home on March 18, 2018 for additional fee information)

The attached registration form and payment are due by April 25, 2018. Once the form and payment are received we will begin to prepare your enrollment packet. Each packet will include your contract, class supply lists and several forms required by the diocese. Completed packages are due back by May 16, 2018. A \$50 re-enrollment fee will be assessed if your registration and packet are received after May 16, 2018.

After consulting with the Pastor, School Administration Team, School Board, and Diocese the attached tuition rates for the 2018-2019 school year have been approved. Again, we are pleased to announce we are using FACTS as our tuition partner. The payment dates will remain the same: 5th, 15th and 20th of the month. Please mark your choice on your registration form. If you would like to pay your tuition in full, the due date is August 10, 2018. You will receive a \$100 discount for the one child, \$150 for two children and \$200 for 3 children.

If you applied for financial aid for the school year 2018 - 2019, I am hoping to notify families by the end of this school year. If you have any concerns, please contact the office.

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Tuition Rates & Fees

St. John Catholic School's tuition rates are well within the diocesan average to ensure accessibility to families who wish to provide their children with an excellent Catholic education. The following tuition plan is effective for the 2018-2019 school year. Tuition rates increase annually in line with projected increase in operational and administrative costs.

Receive a \$100 (1 child), \$150 (2 children), or \$200 (3 children) per family discount if tuition is paid in full by **August 10.**

*Active Parishioner Tuition Rate applies to families who are registered in our St. John the Baptist Parish, regularly attend weekend mass, children have completed all age appropriate sacraments, contribute financial support to the parish through the use of weekly envelopes or EFT, and participate in liturgy. Additionally, families must complete 20 hours of service to benefit the school or parish. (More information will be available in your registration packet)

**Out-of-Parish Tuition Rate applies to all families who do not qualify for the Active Parishioner Tuition Rate. Families are not required to complete twenty (20) hours of service, but will be required to complete a minimum two (2) hours of service at the Fall Festival and participate in at least one (1) classroom activity during the 2018-2019 school year. (More information will be available in your registration packet)
