#### Planning for the Opening of the 2020/2021 School Year:

The Department of Catholic Schools, at the Diocese of Oakland is considering all pertinent data collectively with our state and local health agencies, CAPSO, the CCCEd Committee, CA Superintendents and CA Curriculum Committee to make the most appropriate recommendations as we plan for the new school year. I have been assured that their recommendations will address four core pillars: health/safety, personnel/finances, facilities, and instructional practices. These pillars will be outlined for each of the three delivery systems the diocese will explore: Students continuing with the Distance Learning Platform, Students returning to the School Building Platform and a Hybrid (combined platforms). Planning around these three platforms will be aligned with social distancing guidelines from our local health agencies. The diocesan principals will spend further time discussing this process and timeline during upcoming Root Group gatherings later this week.
