- Finger prints must be cleared before volunteering, this process can take up to 4 weeks.

Safe Environment Training

- Good for up to 3 years (as long as the 3 years fall within the schools 3-year cycle)
- 2017-2018 is the start of the schools new 3-year cycle. After July 1, 2017 ALL volunteers will have to train/retrain to be in compliance.
- There is a **\$5** fee payable to SJCS
