#### Other Things to Note about the Q & A Event:

- These live, Q & A sessions are optional for parents.
- Parents do not have to remain on any one call for the entire session time. Parents are welcomed to join and leave scheduled calls as is relevant to them.
- Parents, please know that these live Q & A sessions are intended to answer general parent questions pertaining to school or class protocol or procedure. This is not a time intended for discussing individual student progress or concerns.
- Parents are encouraged to email teachers directly should they have student-specific or family-specific questions or concerns.
- These Q & A sessions are for parents/guardians only, not for students.

- By or before 9/7- Teacher communication to parents about any information, procedures or protocol relevant for parent review prior to the 9/9 Back to School Q & A Event.
- By or before 9/7- Teacher emailed Google Meet invitation (link) to parents/guardians for optional, live Back to School Q & A session(s).

#### FOOD DROP OFF:

Parents, please note that the school will not accept snack/lunches to be dropped off in the front office. Should a child need a lunch, the school will provide one and a family will be billed.

#### DAILY HEALTH SCREENING:

As you know part of the health and safety protocols for our return to school, each family is asked to fill out the Student COVID-19 Self-Assessment Screening. This form must be completed for each child, each school day **before 7:30am.** 

If your child has a temperature above 100 degrees, or you answer any of the survey questions in the affirmative, please notify Ms. Aimee Sire and **keep your student home**. (This screening form must be filled out the morning the student will be attending school. You may NOT fill it out the night before.)

#### PARISH RAFFLE REQUIREMENT FOR SCHOOL PARENTS:

Each school family will be responsible for selling 10 raffle tickets per family for our parish raffle. Our school receives 50% of the profits from the raffle. The sale of these raffle tickets counts toward each family's festival service hour obligation. This does not count toward the \$300 family fundraising obligation. While we do encourage school family participation at this year's one-day parish festival (more information to come later), the only requirement regarding the festival this year (due to Covid-19) is the raffle sale of 10 tickets per family. The raffle sale will begin once school families receive their raffle tickets and the raffle winners will be drawn at the 11:30am mass on October 3rd. Active parishioners should have already received these raffle tickets in the mail. Out of parish families will receive them from the school as soon as we are provided them from the parish office. If your family needs or would like additional raffle tickets, please contact the front office. Our school families will turn in raffle tickets and money to the school office. Ms. Aimee will keep track of school family participation in the parish raffle. School families who do not sell a minimum of 10 raffle tickets will be assessed a \$50 fee through FACTS. Please keep an eye out for raffle tickets. An email will be sent to parents once these are sent home with students.

#### PROOF OF VACCINATION NEEDED:

If you and/or your student are vaccinated please email us a copy of your vaccination card/s. This information will be kept confidential and will be used only for contact tracing quarantine mandates or for allowing admission into places or events where vaccinations are required. #### **HEALTH & SAFETY:**

Students w/ well-fitting masks-

Does your child's mask fit well- snuggly around the mouth AND nose, without dropping down, below the nose or mouth when they speak, move, yawn?

Masks are our primary defense against the transfer of respiratory droplets and saliva. Well-fitting masks are a non-negotiable at school. Parents, I request that you monitor your child(ren) with a mask on for a period of time during activity to confirm if your child's mask fits properly.


