Wednesday, September 21<sup>st</sup> Picture Day Dear Shamrock Family,

The diocese mandates that all schools participate in a school-wide evacuation/student pick-up drill every other school year to prepare for a large emergency during which we would have to evacuate the school and wait for student pick up. This very important drill provides staff with the opportunities to review and practice search and rescue and first aid protocols. On Thursday, **September 22<sup>nd</sup>** our Disaster Drill will take place, beginning at **noon**. All students will need to be picked up by either a parent or someone listed on their emergency information. Students will only be released to people who are indicated on their emergency list, and people who pick up students must have identification present and ready to provide staff upon release of students. Lastly, there is **no afternoon SEP this day,** so ALL students will need to be picked up during the 12 o'clock hour, via our Disaster Drill dismissal system.

- Students only released to parents/individuals on student emergency list
- o parents are encouraged to update with the front office if necessary
- Students only released to parent/permitted guardian who comes with an ID for formal identification purposes



### **MEDICATIONS ON CAMPUS REMINDER:**

#### **Policy**

- All medication administered require parent/guardian authorization.
- All prescription medication and aspirin require physician and parent/guardian authorization.
- Medications are to be kept in the school office
- An exception will be made if the school has a "Permission to Carry and Self Medicate" form on file, signed off on by both the parent(s) and student's physician.

#### Procedure

- Parent/Guardian is to bring the medication to the office.

- A request form for each prescribed medication must be completed by the student's physician, signed by physician and signed by parent. Faxed forms from the physician are acceptable.

### **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:**

1.) Volunteer Background Checks are required for any person who would like to volunteer, chaperone, or attend class parties. Anyone who wants to enter the school, past the office lobby, during school hours needs to be fingerprinted.

- One time, no expiration.
- Forms can be picked up in the office
- There is a \$34 fee per person payable to SJCS

2.) Safe Environment Training completion is required for any person who would like to volunteer, chaperone, attend class parties, or anyone who wants to enter the school, past the office lobby, during school hours needs to have a current Safe Environment Certificate on file.

- All volunteers will have to complete training through www.virtusonline.org once every 3 years.
- There is a \$5 fee payable to SJCS.

### SHAMROCK PRIDE GROUP MEMBERSHIP FEE DUE:

All families are required to join and actively participate in the parent organization, newly named the Shamrock Pride Group (SPG). There is a required annual membership fee of \$10 per family. This parent organization membership fee is nonrefundable and must be paid before 9/20/22. Funds will be used to put on special events for our shamrock family! ### 72 HOUR STUDENT EMERGENCY KITS

\*\*\*Emergency kits due to your child's teacher no later than September 30, 2022

To ensure that our students will be prepared for an emergency, we are requesting that you send the following emergency supplies to school for each child. Please fit everything into a one- gallon size ziploc bag. Medications should be included as well. Please consider expiration dates for perishable items. (nothing before June 2023).

- (2) 16 fl. oz. bottled water
- (6) individually packed snacks or (1) 2400 Datrix calorie food ration bar
  o (ie: high protein energy bars, granola bar, fruit snacks, trail mix.)
- (1) pair underwear

If your child has any particular medical needs, you should consider including a 48-72 hour supply of medication.

On the front of the bag, write your child's name, the date the contents were assembled, and any emergency telephone numbers or plans that you have for your family. You may also write a letter of reassurance to your child (highly recommended).

The bags will be sent home at the end of the school year and should be replenished with fresh supplies and returned at the beginning of the next school year. Although the hope is that we will never use these kits, your child's safety and comfort are our first concern. Your help and cooperation on this is greatly appreciated.

### St John Talent Show Permission Slip

This permission slip ensures that you are allowing your child to participate in the talent show held on Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup>. By signing this permission slip, you not only give permission for your child to participate in the talent show, but you and your child are agreeing to the following rules and conditions stated below.

### **Rules and Conditions**

- 1. All students who plan to be in the talent show must be present for try-outs.
  - a. Try-outs will be held on Tuesday, September 20th after school (beginning at 3:15pm)
  - **b.** Students are asked to **bring talent show costumes**/attire to try-outs along with this permission slip
  - c. Students are asked to bring their own music and music lyrics to try-outs (all songs/performances must be under 2 minutes)
  - d. All students participating in the talent show that do not have an adult present must sign in to SEP. Students will be checked out of SEP for their tryout by a talent show coordinator and will return to SEP when they are finished. Students with an adult present are asked to line up outside the music room and wait to be called in by talent show coordinators. When students are done trying out, they may leave school or if not picked up, must return to SEP.
- 2. Students whose performance is deemed inappropriate by talent show coordinators will be advised on audition day to make more appropriate adjustments to act, or will be asked to withdraw from the talent show.
- 3. Talent Show performances may be <u>no more than 2 minutes long</u>.
- 4. We encourage all students participating in the talent show to practice outside of school, on their own time. We will also have two group performance rehearsals as stated above.
