- · Forms can be picked up in the office
- · There is a \$34 fee per person payable to SJCS
- 2.) Safe Environment Training completion is required for any person who would like to volunteer, chaperone, attend class parties, or anyone who wants to enter the school, past the office lobby, during school hours needs to have a current Safe Environment Certificate on file.
- All volunteers will have to complete training through <u>www.virtusonline.org</u> once every 3 years.
- · There is a \$5 fee payable to SJCS.
