SJCS HALLOWEEN PARADE, CARNIVAL & CLASS PARTIES ON OCTOBER 31st:

We will celebrate Halloween at St. John on Tuesday, October 31^{st} . Students may come dressed in appropriate Halloween costumes. Please ensure that costumes are not too scary, gory, and that costumes allow students to move freely. No weapon props please. This day will begin with a costume parade in the gym, after morning prayer and announcements. Families are welcomed for this portion. After the parade, our 8^{th} graders will host a carnival for students in grades $TK - 5^{th}$. Halloween pictures will be for sale and individual classes will have classroom parties. This is a noon dismissal day with both before and after school SEP available. Homeroom teachers and/or room parents will share more information.
