ST. JOHN CATHOLIC SCHOOL FAMILY RAFFLE REQUIREMENT

Dear Shamrock Family,

Each year St. John usually hosts a Parish Fall Festival, in which school families participate and offer a minimum of two hours of service, per family. Due to Covid-19 however, this event has been canceled this year. In an effort to still share in raised funds, the parish/school is putting on a raffle in which we will require school parent participation, being that we, as a school, will earn half of money raised from the raffle.

What Parents Need to Know:

- -School families are NOT required to provide 2 hours of service at the fall festival (due to cancelation)
- -School families WILL be REQUIRED to sell (or purchase) a minimum of \$50 worth of raffle tickets. This will replace the two required festival work hours, worth \$25 per hour.
- -Like with required festival service hours, families will be charged for not participating in the raffle (selling or buying \$50 worth of raffle tickets).

NEW INFORMATION:

- In order to receive credit for participation you MUST ensure that you drop your raffle tickets and payment into the SCHOOL DROPBOX. If you drop it off with a parish representative it will not be counted toward your service agreement. Please include the tickets as well as payment in a sealed envelope with your family name clearly printed on the outside of the envelope.
- Because this fulfills your 2 hour festival obligation this does not count toward your \$300 school fundraising commitment.

(Though you may have received sets of tickets for every student in your family, your obligation is a minimum of 10 tickets [\$50] per family not per student)

TICKETS ARE DUE BY FRIDAY OCTOBER 30TH 2:00PM IN THE SCHOOL DROPBOX. NO LATE SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ENTERED INTO THE RAFFLE.

School families, please be on the lookout for the raffle tickets in the mail, or stop by the parish office to pick up tickets. Thank you for your support and good luck!


