Fr. Sergio and I want to provide an update in regards to school reopening for onsite instruction at St. John Catholic School. As you are likely aware, Alameda County has moved up a tier on California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy. Our school's reopening guide was accepted for review by Alameda County Public Health Department, but since then, Alameda County Office of Education has suspended the Elementary Waiver Process, and at this time, schools who choose to reopen, must pursue a new reopening "checklist" component that was given as a directive by Alameda County Office of Education.

While various schools in Alameda County may open later this month, our SJCS administration team firmly believes that now is the time to observe the reopening of other businesses and schools both nationally and locally. From these intentional observations, my administration team and I can continue to track health trends, conduct further research of best practices, and make the necessary adjustments to reopen safely and efficiently.

Most recent parent survey data pertaining to students' return to school favored the continuation of distance learning for the remainder of the 2020 calendar year. Our staff is eager to be reunited on campus with our students, yet they too have shared some considerations that promote further exploration. At this time, our plan is to proceed with distance learning for the duration of trimester 1 (November 13th), continue to monitor and evaluate local metrics, observe reopening successes and challenges of other businesses and schools, and maintain our commitment to evolve reopening protocol with a plan to reevaluate the opportunity for reopening for on campus instruction in November. This is a dynamic situation and our administration team remains committed to responding to the needs of our community, keeping safety and well-being at the forefront of decision making.
