#### Handbook Reminder:

#### Health and Safety - Medications:

- St. John Catholic School may not furnish any medications to students.
- All medication administration requires parent/guardian authorization.
- All prescription medications and aspirin require physician and parent/guardian authorization.
- All medications must be secured in the school office. Exception: back-up inhalers and Epi-Pens may be secured in the classroom as well as the office.
- Use of an Epi-Pen necessitates a 911 call.
- Because of the risk of students sharing medication, no student may carry their own medications. In the event that a student is seriously at risk without an Epi-Pen or inhaler, consideration will be given to a variance when the physician and parent document the following:
  - Risk of not carrying the medication
  - Student has been instructed in the indications, administration, side effects, responsibility not to share, and the responsibility to notify the teacher immediately after use
  - Glucose testing and insulin administration is coordinated by the parent/guardian in collaboration with the Principal
