It is our plan to continue to collaborate with parents regarding ways that we can safely gather together to support our students and strengthen the connectivity of our shamrock family. The pandemic has taken a severe toll on our enrollment, in regards to families having fear to send students back in-person, families losing jobs, moving out of the area to seek more affordable housing or moving to upgrade home size. While it remains my every effort to continue to provide robust learning support and varied enrichment activities to our students, enrollment directly affects our budget and our ability to offer services. With an enrollment decline of 72 students within the past two school years, I am focused on retention and marketing strategies to significantly increase enrollment for the upcoming school year. I will need the support of current parents and school families with efforts to grow our school community. Please look out for future communication pertaining to ways you can help with marketing of SJCS. Let's collaborate so that we can not only ensure that our school survives but thrives!

IN PARISH RATE REQUIREMENTS:

This is just a reminder that to qualify for the In Parish Rate next year (2022-2023 school year) you must have completed the following prior to May 2022:

- Sell \$50 worth of raffle tickets for the Fall Festival
- 20 service hours between the parish and school

(see the Family Service Hour Program for more details)

- Register with the parish and regularly attend mass
- All age appropriate student sacraments compete
- Contribute a **minimum of \$200** to either the school's Annual Fund or the parish through the use of their weekly envelopes/EFT or a combination of both.

ALL FAMILIES SHAMROCK PRIDE GROUP MEMBERSHIP FEE DUE:

New this school year, all families are required to join and actively participate in the parent organization, newly named the Shamrock Pride Group (SPG). There is a required annual membership fee of \$10 per family. This parent organization membership fee is nonrefundable. Funds will be used to put on special events for our shamrock family!
