With an enrollment decline of 72 students within the past two school years, we are focused on retention and marketing strategies to significantly increase enrollment for the upcoming school year. IN PARISH RATE REQUIREMENTS:

This is just a reminder that to qualify for the In Parish Rate next year (2022-2023 school year) you must have completed the following prior to May 2022:

- Sell \$50 worth of raffle tickets for the Fall Festival
- 20 service hours between the parish and school (see the Family Service Hour Program for more details)
- Register with the parish and regularly attend mass
- All age appropriate student sacraments compete
- Contribute a **minimum of \$200** to either the school's Annual Fund or the parish through the use of their weekly envelopes/EFT or a combination of both.

COVID-19 VACCINATION NOTICE:

To ensure the safety of our students, any adults attending a St. John Catholic School special event must be vaccinated. 
