Construction to Begin on BART Elevated Structures at Ashland Avenue in San Lorenzo

Construction Details

Summary of Activity

Earthquake strengthening construction will begin on BART's elevated structures (columns) at Ashland Avenue in San Lorenzo. The work includes adding steel and concrete to foundations, and protecting utilities and equipment.

Estimated Start Date

Late October 2016

Estimated Duration

Through early 2017

Impacts

- Temporary shifting of traffic and narrowing of driving lanes
- Intermittent lane closures and traffic delays
- Sidewalk closures and periodic changes to pedestrian access in areas of construction
- Limited night work for installation of krails and safety shields
- Increased noise, dust and traffic related to construction work

General Work Hours

Monday-Friday, 7 am to 7 pm, with some night work and emergency work as needed

Dear Community Member,

As part of our systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, BART is strengthening elevated structures to better withstand earthquakes. Starting in late October 2016, construction will begin on the Ashland Avenue underpass in San Lorenzo. The work includes adding steel and concrete to columns, while protecting utilities and equipment.

During construction, modifications to traffic lanes on Ashland Avenue will be required to allow space for the work. During the project, you can expect construction-related traffic delays, noise, dust and minor inconveniences. You can also expect temporary sidewalk closures. The sidewalks will be closed, one side at a time, and pedestrians will be directed to use the open sidewalk on the opposite side of the street. Work will occur in the daytime between the hours of 7 am to 7 pm, Monday through Friday. Limited night work may be required to place traffic control and will occur between the hours of 8 pm and 6 am, Monday through Friday.

Please watch for signs with safety information and other notices. We appreciate your patience during this work, and will attempt to minimize construction-related noise, dust and inconvenience.

Related work to strengthen the Bay Fair Station and station stairwells at Hayward Station will also occur between 2016 and mid-2017. Earthquake Safety Program construction will be underway at various locations throughout the BART system over the next seven years, and is expected to be complete by the end of 2022. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Our aim is to strengthen BART as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.
