Dear Shamrock Family,

I have some great news to share regarding an upgrade in our registration process. Beginning in February, registration for the 2022-2023 school year will be done completely online. Not only will this streamline the registration process but it will also allow our administration team to more accurately obtain an enrollment count in order to more efficiently plan for and allocate recourses and staff for the upcoming school year. Registration for returning families will now be conducted between February 7th through February 28th. Emails will be sent out with individual links for families to complete the necessary forms and pay registration online. (More information about the specifics of this process will be coming in the next month.)

Registration is due between February 7th through February 28th. Registration payments made after February 28th will be assessed a \$50 re-enrollment fee.

As with any instance at St. John, if accommodations need to be made, we will try our best to provide them. Small changes like this upgrade to our registration process will not only assist with our planning for the 2022-2023 school year, but will help guide budgetary decisions in order to allow St. John Catholic School to be economically sustainable for years to come. CHRISTMAS PROGRAM 2021

In an effort to both bring back some holiday tradition and promote continued health among our school community, this year's Christmas Program will be recorded and made available to the entire community so that all students, staff, and school families can view the Christmas Program in its entirety. During this recording we will have a limited number of seats available to watch live. The Christmas Program recording will take place in the gym, during the school day, by level on **Friday, December 17th.**

Christmas Program Schedule:

Seating will be limited to only **80 available seats per level**. Parents/family members who are **Covid-19 vaccinated** and those adults who have **fingerprinting and updated Safe Environment clearance on file in the school office** may be permitted into the gym to watch the Christmas Program from the bleachers, at a distance from students. Please note: **You may only sign up if you have been fully vaccinated and have a copy of your vaccination card on file in the office, have fingerprint clearance on file in the office, and are up to date on your safe environment training and have a current certificate on file in the office, PRIOR TO SIGNING UP**. If you sign up and we haven't received all 3 of these items your name will be removed from the list. Please inquire with Ms. Aimee (asire@csdo.org) about items you may have or need on file with her.

Items you need to attend Christmas Program:

- Vaccination card (showing full vaccination status)- For individuals 5 years and older
- Livescan fingerprint clearance (for those 18 years and older)
- Up-to-date Safe Environment certificate (for those 18 years and older)

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL FOR UNVACCINATED STUDENTS:

While there is no current California mandate on travel, there are recommendations regarding precautions for people who travel internationally and specifically for those who are not fully vaccinated. The CDC provides the guidance below which we are following in regards to students who return from international travel. I have highlighted the portion to which we paid special attention in regards to unvaccinated children.

After Arrival in the United States

You might have been exposed to COVID-19 on your travels. You might feel well and not have any symptoms, but you can still be infected and spread the virus to others. For this reason, CDC recommends the following:

All Travelers

RECOMMENDED

- Get tested with a COVID-19 viral test 3–5 days after travel.
- o Find a <u>U.S. COVID-19 testing locationExternal Link</u> near you.
- · Self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.
- · Follow all <u>state and local</u> recommendations or requirements after travel.

If You are NOT Fully Vaccinated

RECOMMENDED

In addition to the testing recommendations above

- Stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative at 3–5 days.
- If you don't get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.

SJCS students who are **not** fully vaccinated (2 doses, and 2 weeks after 2nd dose) will need to be quarantined for 7 days and get tested within the 3-5 day window after return to the US, prior to being permitted to return to school for in-person learning. We ask that any parents of unvaccinated students who will be traveling internationally please alert Ms. Aimee (asire@csdo.org) of your trip dates and allow Ms. Aimee to confirm with you appropriate Covid-19 testing dates, as well as a return to school date. We thank you for your patience and understanding, as it is our obligation to take precautions during this time, especially in light of the new Omicron variant.
