## Covid-19 Impact

### **COVID Related Financial Loss:**

Safety upgrades & supplies: \$2,429 since July 2020

Hybrid learning/technology: \$2,033 Since July 2020

Tuition assistance: \$29,669

Families that unenrolled/did not re-enroll: \$273,589

Unfulfilled service hours at \$25/hr: \$33,975

Total Loss: \$341,695

## Significant Accomplishments

## Significant Accomplishments

#### R.E.A.D. Learning Support Program

Largest Student Growth Percentile = 67

**100**% of students moved out of the bottom 25<sup>th</sup> percentile

**20**% started above the 50th percentile and continue to improve showing readiness to graduate out of program

10% of students moved to above 50th percentile (who did not start there)

2020 Fall: 63rd percentile ranking

2021 Winter: 66th percentile ranking

Our students perform better in math than 66 % of students in the same grades nationwide

Special recognition:

Winter 2021 2nd Grade = 87th percentile

13 have already enrolled




