Letter from the Principal

This Sunday is Easter, the greatest feast in the Christian calendar. On this Sunday, we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Easter is a day of celebration because it represents the fulfillment of our faith as Christians.

St. Paul wrote that, unless Christ rose from the dead, our faith is in vain (1 Corinthians 15:17). Through his death, Christ saved mankind from sin, and He destroyed the hold that death has on all of us; but it is His Resurrection that gives us the promise of new life, both in this world and the next.

That new life began on Easter Sunday. In the Lord's Prayer, we pray "Thy Kingdom come, on earth as it is in Heaven." And Christ told His disciples that some of them would not die until they saw the Kingdom of God "coming in power" (Mark 9:1). Easter is the fulfillment of that promise. With the resurrection of Christ, God's Kingdom is established on earth, in the form of the Church.

Celebrate with your family and loved ones, for God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. (John 3:16)
