SJCS Students may only attend the festival after they have been signed out of SEP and accompanied by an authorized adult.

## **Attention Shamrock Families!**

Parents, due to festival set-up, please be advised that we have to conduct a modified student pick up on Thursday and Friday of this week. The school has been notified that a trailer be blocking the path for the cars that come from the entrance by the rectory as early as Thursday afternoon. The rectory/church parking lot will be blocked off Friday due to festival booths being set up in that lot. **Parents please know that you can only enter from the larger gym side lot for dismissal next Friday and potentially next Thursday (depending upon booth rental drop off) and that dismissal of students will only be to the two lines in the GYM parking lot.** We apologize for any inconvenience.

## **Blessing of the Animals**

Blessing of the Animals prayer service will be held on Thursday at 2:25pm in the school play yard. Parents/guardians are welcomed to bring pets on leash, in crates, or held by hand to this special prayer service to receive a blessing. Animals that are brought by parent/guardian to receive a blessing are to remain behind the coned off area, closest to the black gate. Animals are NOT to be allowed near students in individual class lines, but rather students whose families are present with their animal may go to their animal/guardian, but not the other way around. We do not want students who are either afraid of or allergic to animals subjected to them in close proximity. If a particular family pet cannot be in attendance at the prayer service on Thursday, then students may bring a picture of a pet for a blessing. Students will just be expected to hold up the picture of their pet when either Fr. Sergio or Fr. Joseph comes around with holy water.

Please note that students may not come to school with their pet, but pets must be brought to school by a cleared adult (Fingerprint & Safe Environment) around 2:25pm.


