Dear Shamrock Family,

Please use caution when driving through the school parking lot(s). During drop off, the large gym lot is to be accessed. Please note that there is only one drop off lane during this time. In order to support our students' safety, please practice the following protocol during student drop off:

- 1. Only drive in one lane (not driving alongside/passing any car in line for student drop off)
- 2. Direct your student(s) to exit the car from the right side of the vehicle
- 3. Direct your student(s) to look around to survey their surroundings when walking to the gym
- 4. Drive at a slow speed when driving through parking lot
- 5. When departing from your student(s after drop off, check over both shoulders and all surroundings for pedestrians before driving away
- 6. If your student(s) require your assistance getting out of the car, please park in a designated spot
- 7. Parents are always welcomed to park and walk their student(s) up to the gym to provide safety support










# BOX TOPS CLIPS
