Dear Families,

It is festival time, this Friday and Saturday! Let's come together as a community and celebrate with one another enjoying great food, music, games, and camaraderie. Below is what you need to know for the very exciting few days ahead:

1. **Thursday:** Festival booth setup will begin Thursday afternoon at 3:00pm. We ask that no one park in the church parking lot closest to the school on Thursday after 3:00pm or anytime on Friday-Sunday. All are welcomed to come out and help setup for the festival on Thursday afternoon/evening.

2. Friday:

Attire for students

- a) Students may come to school in 'free dress' attire that CLEARLY represents their class' chosen decade.
- Students may come to school in their uniform top and free dress bottoms
- c) Students may come to school in their regular school uniform.






