Letter from the Principal

In the coming weeks, I will be introducing you to WCEA and St. John Catholic School's accreditation process. This is the beginning of a busy but extremely important period as we prepare ourselves for the scheduled accreditation visit in March 2017.

What is WCEA? The acronym stands for Western Catholic Educational Association. WCEA has developed a self-study protocol in association with the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) focused on improving student learning. St. John Catholic School will be working toward accreditation with WCEA.

What is the focus for accreditation?

The focus for accreditation is on assessing student success in meeting School-wide Learning Expectations (SLEs), diocesan and local curriculum standards, and other governing authority expectations that demonstrate improvement in student learning.

Who is involved in this accreditation process?

This process involves ALL of our stakeholders – students, faculty and staff, board members, parishioners, and YOU, our school families, who believe in our mission to strive for academic excellence in a supportive and welcoming Christ-centered community.

How can you help? There will be many ways for parents to engage in the accreditation process. First, please be sure to complete the Catholic Identity Survey that was distributed on Monday. This information will be used to celebrate our successes and set goals for the future. Thank you for being here in this place at this time as we work to create a positive future for our students at St. John Catholic School.

WCEA Survey – Catholic Identity

On Tuesday, April 12 all families received an email with a link to a survey about Catholic Identity at St John Catholic School. Results will be used to highlight strengths and develop action plans for our WCEA/WASC accreditation. Your feedback is important to us as we work to make St. John Catholic School the best it can be.

For families who do not have access to a computer or Internet access, we will make our school's computer lab available this Thursday, April 14 from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m. for families to complete this survey.

St. John Catholic School Health Audit

Each year, the Diocese of Oakland conducts a health audit at each of the 44 elementary schools in our diocese. St. John Catholic School was audited on Monday, April 4.

Laws regarding TB testing and immunizations have changed, and you may have received a notice from Ms. Serrano asking for specific records or information for your child. By law, we are required to have immunization, health check, and TB testing results on file at school. We ask for your cooperation and submit the requested information as soon as possible.

Tuition**

How is a tuition increase determined?

First, we analyze our fixed costs given to us by the diocese, such as salaries and benefits, diocesan assessments, insurance, permits and licensing fees. Those costs have increased 7-10% for next year. Next, we look at our current expenses and trends, and project capital purchases such as technology, textbooks and curriculum, etc. We analyze utilities, property taxes, and county fees. A lot goes in to balancing a \$1.2 million operating budget!

How does SJCS remain competitive?

Quality Catholic education **must** remain affordable and attainable for our families. With that in mind, we have made a modest increase of \$30/month per student, equivalent to \$300/year.

With this increase, we believe a quality education at St. John Catholic School is still within reach. Our tuition is still below the diocesan average, and we continue to be competitive compared to other Catholic elementary schools in our Southern Alameda County area.

How does SJCS achieve academic excellence with technology? In addition, we will assess a \$50 technology fee to begin paying for the technology hardware improvements and expected costs for licensing as we continue to be a leader in educational technology at St. John Catholic School.

How is placement on tuition scales determined? Based on information from two separate audits with our parish offices (November 2015 and April 2016), families have now been placed in the correct tuition scale.
