Handbook Reminder of the Week

Each week, look for a gentle reminder from our 2015-2016 Parent/Student Handbook. This week we will focus on the St. John Catholic School **Reporting Absences:**

When a student is absent, the parent/guardian must notify the office by 8:30 a.m. each day of the absence. If the office does not receive a phone call by this time, the school will contact the parent/guardian for verification of the absence. At that time, requests for homework should be made. If a parent does not request homework, it will not be prepared for the student. If a parent requests homework in the morning, it will be placed on the Homework Table next to the school office at the end of the school day to be picked up before 3:30 p.m.

A student who has been absent from school is required upon return to present a written excuse stating the reason for the absence, and the letter must be signed by the student's parent/guardian. These letters are required to be kept on file by each teacher until the end of the school year.

Alert from the Catholic Schools Department of the Diocese of Oakland Dear school families.

We are excited to launch a new service that will enhance communication by allowing us to deliver important information to you via SMS text messaging. The service is powered by <u>SchoolMessenger</u>. In order to receive announcements and emergency communications via text, you must "optin" to receive these messages.

On Wednesday evening [tonight] you will receive an SMS text message asking if you are willing to receiving texts from the Diocese of Oakland Catholic Schools. Although all Diocese schools share this system, you will only receive messages from our school except in the case of a regional emergency.

Please note, although there is no charge for this service, it does not pay for text message charges that may be incurred by you for sending or receiving text messages. Check with your wireless carrier for possible charges. You may opt-out of this service at any time by texting STOP to 68453.


